



CC2000 Club Development Grant for Greater Cleveland Council of Figure Skating Clubs

Overview

Retaining current skaters and recruiting new ones is critical for figure skating clubs to thrive. The **CC2000 Club Development Grant** program for the 2021/22 figure skating season provides clubs with funds to grow and retain members. Each figure skating club may apply for a grant of up to \$1,000 to create programs or events designed to grow their membership.

Grant Guidelines

The grants, up to \$1,000 per club, are designed to assist figure skating clubs develop events to keep members engaged and retain and recruit members. Clubs are encouraged to work with their rinks to expand Learn-to-Skate programs or create events that grow club membership and increase rink utilization.

Grant funding is only available to member clubs in the GCC. The monies can be spent on all rink expenses that support the program goal.

Examples

- Stage a pop show to showcase club skaters. Host a L-T-S session before or after to promote membership.
- Develop community L-T-S days working in conjunction with your rink.
- Any event that promotes membership recruitment and retention.
